1 Assignment of Intellectual Property Rights

1.2 I confirm and warrant that:

1.2.1 subject to the rights of any owner of any intellectual property rights in third party materials and, if any, those of my co-contributors I am the sole and beneficial owner of the Contribution IPR and it is my original work; and

1.2.2 I have full power and authority to enter into this Assignment,

1.2.3 the Contribution does not contain any libellous matter or infringe any copyright or other intellectual property rights or any other rights of any third party; and

1.2.4 the Contribution has not been published before and is not currently under consideration for publication elsewhere.

1.3 Where the Contribution contains third party material:

1.3.1 I confirm that I have sought and obtained the permission from the owner of any intellectual property rights in such materials to make available such third party materials to EUP for use of that third party material in the Journal and that I have included the appropriate acknowledgements of the rights of such owner of any intellectual property rights in such materials in the Contribution; and

2.2 In assigning the Contribution IPR, I (and, where applicable, the other contributors) retain the following rights:

- 2.2.1 The right to post either the Author's Original (AO) or Accepted Manuscript (AM) version of the Contribution on my personal or departmental web page. Any posting of the AM version should include a prominent statement that the article has been accepted for publication by EUP in the Journal, together with a link to the EUP website for the Journal. Where possible, the link should be updated after publication, to link directly to the article abstract page on EUP Journals Online, and the full bibliographic details should be included (journal title, volume: issue, date, page numbers);
 - 2.2.2 The right to post the AM version of the Contribution in my Institutional Repository. The posting should include a prominent statement that the article has been accepted for publication by EUP in the Journal, together with a link to the EUP website for the Journal. Where possible, the link should be updated after publication, to link directly to the article abstract page on EUP Journals Online, and the full bibliographic details should be included (journal title, volume: issue, date, page numbers);
 - 2.2.2.1 the right to post the AM version of the Contribution in my Institutional Repository with a Creative Commons Attribution (CC BY) licence, if instructed to do so by my Institution or by the terms and conditions of my employment.
 - 2.2.3 The right to post the AM version of the Contribution in a subject repository that does not offer content for commercial sale, one year following publication in print. The posting should include a prominent statement that the article has been accepted for publication by EUP in the Journal together with a link to the EUP website for the Journal. Where possible, the link should be updated after publication, to link directly to the article abstract page on EUP Journals Online, and the full bibliographic details should be included (journal title, volume: issue, date, page numbers);
 - 2.2.4 The right to post the AO version of the Contribution in commercial repositories such as SSRN and social networking sites such as ResearchGate and Academia.edu at any time. The AM version and Version of Record (VoR) may not be shared on social media sites.
 - 2.2.5 The right to use the Version of Record (VoR) for my own teaching needs or to supply on an individual basis to research colleagues, provided that such supply is not for commercial purposes; and
 - 2.2.6 The right to reuse the Contribution for non-commercial, personal or business purposes, including for education purposes and presentations and to make derivative works from the Contribution including adapting the Contribution into books or chapters of books (in all cases provided that such reuse or derivative works do not compete with the business of EUP and full bibliographic acknowledgement is made).
- 2.3 For the purposes of Clause 2.2, "Author's Original (AO)" means the un-refereed version of an article, also called 'preprint', "Accepted Manuscript (AM)" means the version of the article that has been accepted for publication in the Journal following the process of peer-review (but before typesetting and proof correction), also called 'postprint', and "Version of Record (VoR)" means the definitive version of the article as published by EUP.

I agree that I shall at all times at the request of EUP execute all documents and do any further acts as EUP may reasonably require to give effect to the Assignment contained in this document and in the event that I fail to do the same within seven (7) days of receipt of written request to, I irrevocably appoint EUP as my attorney with the right but not the obligation to execute all such documents and do all such further acts as EUP may decide in relation to the Contribution.
